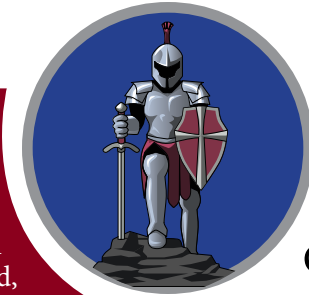

The See's Candy Fundraiser is coming in October. More details will follow soon.

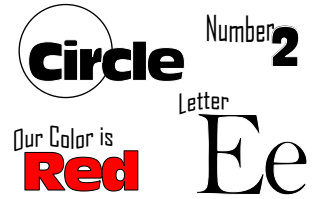
