We hope the Lord continues to bless you and keep you. Below are important reminders coming up for VCA PTF.

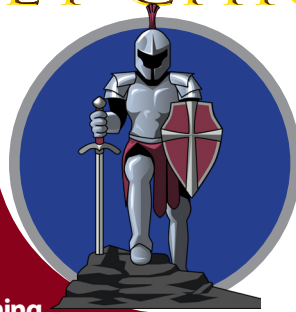
