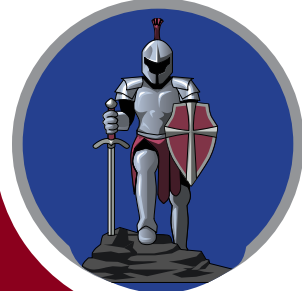


### Chain Reaction Youth Group
