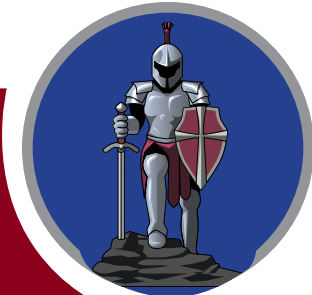

## Fifth Grade

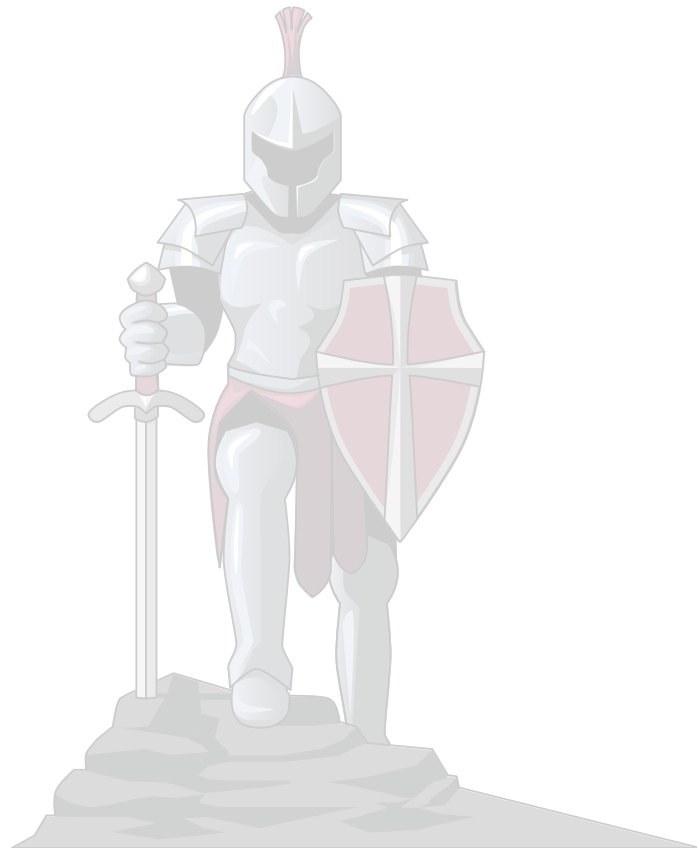
