Can you believe it's June already? Please continue to work hard to finish this school year strong.

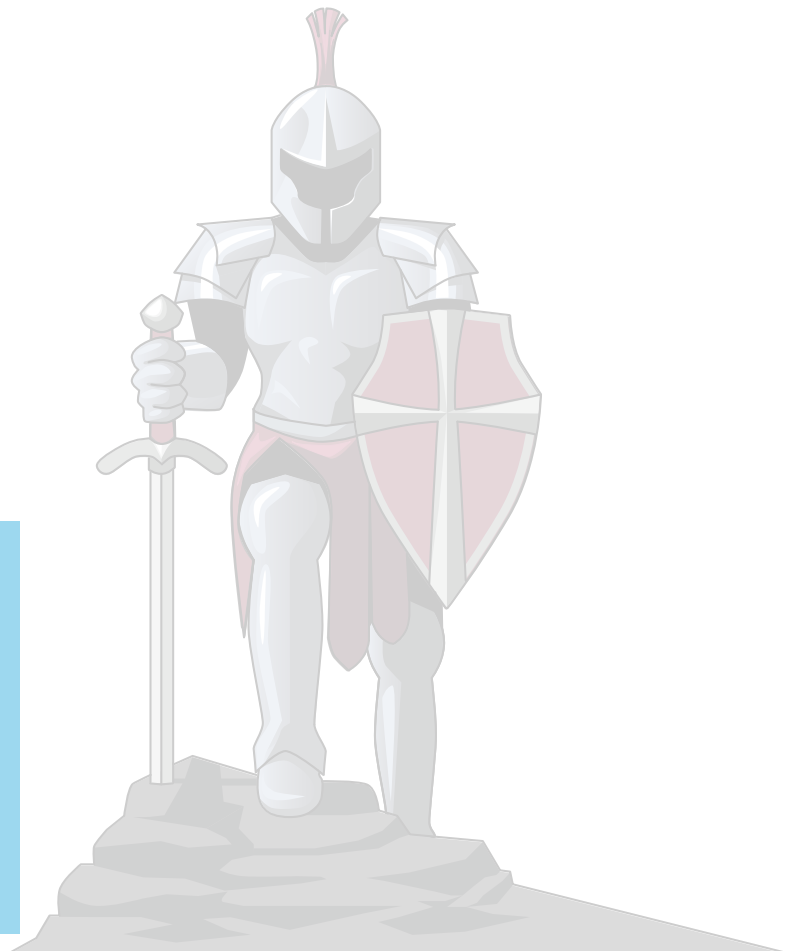
It's going to be warm this week so please be sure to bring your water bottle every day.
