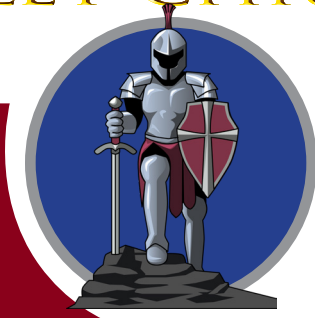

Picture day is a free dress day. Students should follow the dress code as stated in the handbook.

Students are expected to come to school dressed in a manner that assures adequate modesty. Clothing must fit properly; not too tight which can cause the student to be uncomfortable or immodest; and not too large. Clothing must not sag. Students are expected to be neat, clean, and clothing should be in good repair (not faded, torn or worn out) when they come to school. All undergarments must be covered. Shorts, skorts, or skirts cannot be shorter than four inches above the bended knee. Clothing including shoes may not have real life or animated characters, super-heroes, or inappropriate logos. Students are to wear athletic shoes.

Pre-K -

Hello parents and grandparents! I hope all is well with you all! A couple of things to let you know about. We will be leading the flags and performing a song in Chapel on Friday, April 12th, at 9:00am in the sanctuary. Also, we have the spring play coming in a few weeks so be sure to mark your calendars for that! It will be April 25th at 5:00pm! And spring pictures are Thursday April 11th. It is a free dress day! Uniform is not required that day!

Kindergarten -

Spring pictures are this Thursday- Attire is free dress! Shoes must still be athletic style.

First Grade -

Whew! First graders completed a week of SAT testing! Mr. Mikulski is so proud of his students; they were so diligent and serious when the test was being administrated. It took so long to complete. 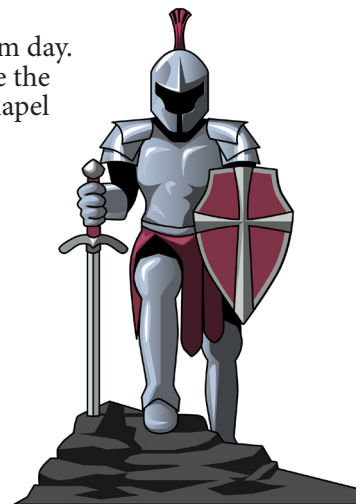
Middle School -
