#### Pre-K -

We'll be focusing on the numbers 19 and 20 and the letters K, V, W, Y and P. This month's color is pink and our shape is heart! Have a great week!

Kindergarten -

Hello Kindergarten Families! We are welcoming this new month of February! Our kindergartners are making a lot of progress in their reading and we are so proud of them. Please continue to work with them at home. Remember repetition is key and we have seen the growth. There will be no school on the 14th or the 17th of this month. Please continue to read the bottom of your child's homework packet. I always have important announcements and upcoming events printed at the bottom. I hope you all have a blessed day and thank you parents for all your efforts to help your child at home, it means so much to us teachers.

#### First Grade -

In First Grade we are continuing with addition along with renaming. We will begin two digit subtraction. In Bible we are studying the feeding of the 5,000, learning the importance of sharing. In science students will be taught about scientists and what they do as they apply the scientific method. In phonics we have started Chart 11. We are becoming capable readers! We are forming sentences in Language and learning how to put words in A B C order.
