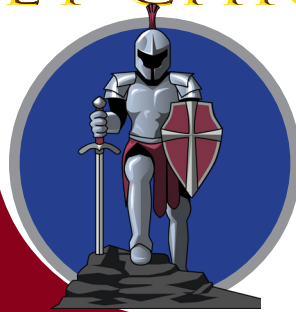

Pre-K -

Keep practicing counting to 100! Also, I want to let you know that we will be doing a performance for you all on April 24 at 5:00 P.M. so be sure to mark your calendars!

Kindergarten -

Hello Kindergarten Families!

Thank you to all for making the effort to work with your child's t-shirt project. I loved seeing all their creative work. This Wednesday is Spirit Day and it is Dr. Seuss dress up/Mismatch Day. On Friday it will be Minimum Day, please still pack a healthy snack for your child. Friendly reminder that on March 3rd will be the Science Fair and although Kindergarten is not required to participate, I would highly encourage you all to be involved in this fun project. On March 4th will be Open House at 7pm. Hope to see you all there. Have a blessed week!

First Grade -

First Grade has been joined by the third and fifth graders in preparation for the musical "Nic at Night." The story line focuses on Nicodemus meeting with Jesus at night. In Bible we are studying about the widow's gift and giving from the heart. In language we are learning about prefixes, suffixes, and alphabetizing to the second letter. In math we are comparing measurements, ordering objects, and learning how to use a thermometer. In science we are studying plants, and in God as the creator. First grade is presently working on a special project, completing a poster: "All About Me." This is due on Feb. 28.

Second Grade -

Fourth Grade -

Middle School -

Tests and due dates for the week are as follows: Tuesday: 7th History Ch. 9 test, Fundamentals of Math Ch. 5 test, 8th Science Ch. 13 Test; Thursday: 6th Science element wanted posters and case files. Science Fair projects are due next Monday, March 3.

The tests and due dates for the week are as follows: Wednesday: 7; Thursday: 7 Pre-Algebra Test; Friday: 8 Literature Test. The 7th and 8th grades should read 20 pages of the assigned book a night. 8th grade has been reading Amari and the Night Brothers, whereas 7th grade started reading The Giver. Both their reports are due on March 21. This week the 7th graders should be on Science Fair Week 7, where they are completing the final draft of their research paper and practicing their presentation in front of family. Wednesday, the 26th, is a school spirit day. The students may dress as their favorite Dr. Seuss character or wear their craziest mismatched outfits. Friday, the 28th, is a minimum day. The Science Fair projects are due on Monday, March 3, and Open House is on Tuesday, March 4th at 7 pm.
