Pre-K -

Kindergarten -

Hello Kindergarten Families! The last day to turn in any missing work is on Wednesday, March 26th. Friday is Minimum day, please still pack a healthy snack. On Wednesday is also Spirit Day, it will be Crazy Hair/Hat Day. First Grade -

Second Grade -

Third Grade -

We have an exciting week ahead of us! On Tuesday we have a science test over chapter 6. Wednesday is our language quiz over plural and possessive nouns, plus word usage.
